that the Office of Development has recommended the purchase of the PeopleSoft Contributor Relations Software to maintain records on constituent information for both individuals and organizations, capture commitments, analyze giving, manage prospects, plan events, manage fund raising campaigns, manage volunteers and allow the colleges to view lifetime commitments from donors, open pledges, and gifts/payments; and

that OIT has recommended the following actions:

Purchase the Campus Directory Interface Software which allows OIT to manage the creation of computer access accounts for new employees and the deletion of computer access for employees who are separated from CCC

Purchase of Enterprise Portal Software that will be used to access the PeopleSoft Student Administration System and the Contributor Relations System

Contracting with PeopleSoft to conduct a technical workshop on the Portal Software, install the Contributor Relations Software, and provide training on the Contributor Relation Software; and

that OIT staff has received a proposal from PeopleSoft to provide the software at a cost not to exceed \$122,688.00 for the three software licenses; to provide one year of software maintenance services at a cost not to e maintenance services at a cost not to e installation and professional services at a total cost not to exceed \$219,026.00; and maintenance services at a cost not to exceed \$24,538.00, and to provide training, nstallation and professional services at a cost not to exceed \$71,800.00 resulting in a

that this professional service agreement and computer software is exempt from competitive procurement.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the agreement with PeopleSoft, Inc. for software licenses for Contributor Relations, Campus Directory Interface and Portal at a cost not to exceed \$122,688.00; to provide one year of maintenance services on the software at a cost not to exceed \$24,538.00, and for professional services to provide installation and training services at a cost not to exceed \$71,800.00 resulting in a total cost not to exceed \$219,026.00 and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute any documents
