
REPORTS

that Harold Washington College recently joined in the celebration of a 20-year partnership with CASA Central in the training of Certified Nurse Assistants in the Humboldt Park community. CASA Central is a community base organization founded in 1964 by Reverend Daniel Alvarez, former Commissioner of Human Services for the City of Chicago.

that on Thursday, October 2, 2003 Harold Washington College Vice President John Wozniak gave the keynote speech in which he referred to CASA Central as a beacon within the Humboldt Park community and noted that Harold Washington College and CASA Central have been in partnership training CNAs since 1983. In that time over 1,000 Certified Nurse Assistants have been trained.

that the completion rate for the Harold Washington College/CASA Central Certified Nurse Assistant Program is virtually 100%, that while the program is delivered in English, virtually all of the participants are bilingual and upon graduation play a critical role in the Hispanic community providing nursing assistance services in hospitals, long term care institutions, and private homes.



REPORTS

that there is a need to approve the continuation of the contract with Scholarship & Guidance Association (S & GA), Chicago, IL and Truman Middle College High School (TMCHS) for the provision of individual and group counseling services to students, training to faculty and consultation with the TMCHS Principal; and

that S & GA's goals are to assist the at-risk student population to improve coping skills and improve academic performance, work with parents, network with other social service agencies and to consult with staff in maintaining a unified learning strategies/behavioral intervention approach; the proposed contract serves 190 students, from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 and includes a licensed clinical social worker and a secretary for a total of \$45,000; S & GA has provided these services for the past 15 years for TMCHS; and

that this purchase of professional services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.


RECOMMENDS


