REPORTS that Malcolm X College in partnership with the Illinois NAACP Youth Division and the Chicago Metro Youth Council conducted an Illinois NAACP Youth convention summit on Saturday, October 4, 2003.

The purpose of the event was to engage more than 40 youth leaders throughout Chicago and the suburban areas in "Empowering Youth Into the New Millennium". The youth program was aimed at families and young people (ages 7 to 25). Chicago Public schools, Chicago Park District, community organizations, state and federal agencies and private elementary/secondary schools were the targeted areas.

FURTHER the summit began at 9:00 am and concluded at 4:00 pm in the auditorium. Approximately 500 attendees participated. The DOW Foundation made a presentation to the Chicago Area Project's Youth as Resources program. Students were given pointers on leadership development, getting into the college of their choice and communication.
