REPORTS

that Washington College for several years has operated a taxi driver training program in cooperation with the City of Chicago Department of Consumer Services; all successful completers of the two week taxi training course at Washington are required to complete a comprehensive two hour on the road instructional driver training course (in addition to passing the City's licensure examination) as the final component of the licensing process to become a public chauffeur in the City of Chicago; and

that staff has identified three driver training firms in the City that are qualified to provide this training and have been reviewed and approved by the City of Chicago: Asia Driving School, Chicago, IL, A-Orland Park Driving School, Orland Park, IL and Capital Driving School, Evanston, IL; the Department of Consumer Services has agreed to a total cost of \$125.00 per student for the provision of this service for a total estimated annual cost of \$180,000.00; staff has reviewed the qualifications of these firms based on their previous experience and approval by the City, and recommends authorization to enter into annual agreements with these firms to provide the comprehensive on the road instructional driver training course through September 30, 2004; and

that this purchase of professional services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements.


RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorize the Chairman to enter into agreements with Asia Driving School, Chicago, IL, A-Orland Park Driving School, Orland Park, IL and Capital Driving School, Evanston, IL for the period of October 2003 through September 30, 2004. Each contract shall be in the amount of \$60,000 for a total estimated cost of \$180,000.00.
