



The camp served 10 inner city youth, many of whom were on scholarships. Commissioner Thomas Walker, City of Chicago Department of Aviation, gave the keynote address at the camp graduation ceremonies Aug. 1 at the college.

The purpose of the camp was to introduce teens to flying and aviation related careers. Camp participants learned about airplanes, flying and flight safety. They built and launched their own rockets and took field trips to the Midway Airport Control Tower and to Lewis University, where they flew in a single engine aircraft. They also took a field trip to the Oshkosh (Wis.) Air Show, where they talked to aviation professionals. Some 75 youth from Chicago Public Schools accompanied them to Oshkosh.

The camp was a collaborative effort between the FAA, Wright College, the Organization of Black Airline Pilots, and the National Black Coalition of Federal Aviation Employees. Omega Airport Transportation Company and several other area businesses were sponsoring supporters.
