**RESOLUTION
EXTENDED U-PASS USAGE
FOR FULL-TIME CITY COLLEGES OF CHICAGO STUDENTS
FOR EXTENDED FALL 2004 SEMESTER**

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

the City Colleges of Chicago experienced a three week strike during the Fall 2004 semester, thus necessitating the extension of the semester to January 22, 2005; and

the Fall 2004 U-Pass Program ends December 18, 2004, thus leaving 8,640 full-time City Colleges of Chicago students with courses extended to January without transportation; and

the Chicago Transit Authority has agreed to extend special consideration to full time City Colleges students to continue their U-Pass privileges for 20 days at \$.60 per day.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the 8,640 full time students continuing their courses during the extended semester of January 3-22, 2005 be granted a U-Pass extension at a total cost to the colleges of \$103,680

FINANCIAL

\$103,680 – divided between colleges participating in the U-Pass program based on full time students attending extended courses
