REPORTS Fall 2004 is a very busy time for the employees at the University of Chicago Hospital (UCHA). Through programs established by the University of Chicago Hospital Academy and Harold Washington College, they had the opportunity to participate in five different course offerings delivered on-site at the Hospitals, and

that 27 employees interested in getting their bachelors or masters degrees in nursing signed up for MA 125, Introductory Statistics. Nearly thirty hospital employees interested in pursuing a career in nursing or allied health are taking BIO 226, Human Structure and Function I. The UCH Academy arranged for these students to access lab facilities, microscopes and cadavers used by students and faculty at the University of Chicago. Hospital employees who wished to pursue other degrees registered for Math 118, Speech 101 and English 102. Over 70 students enrolled in courses this fall, and

that in addition to Harold Washington College, the University of Chicago Hospitals currently have on-site education partnerships with the University of Illinois at Chicago, Governors State University, Illinois State University, Moraine Valley Community College, Oakton Community College, Wright College and Rio Solado College in Phoenix, Arizona. Together these institutions provide UCH employees with a wide array of learning opportunities to further their education and professional development.
