REPORTS that Wilbur Wright College hosted the Chicago Police Department's Community Conference on Police Response to Deaf and Disabled People Aug. 11 and 12. Chicago Police Superintendent Philip J. Cline addressed the group.

The conference brought together about 250 police officers, representatives from social service agencies and community groups for a dialogue on how to best serve individuals with disabilities.

Some 25 deaf students from Whitney Young High School also attended and participated in a seminar on teen dating violence.

The Conference was a Chicago Police Department outreach effort aimed at increasing awareness and improving domestic violence services to deaf and disabled people.
