that there is a need to purchase the following Scantron ES2260 OMR Scanner and maintenance for the Adult Education programs at Daley College, Malcolm X College and Truman College:

Total Cost -- All Colleges - \$40,887.00; and

that the proposal from Scantron has been reviewed and approved by college staff; this scanning equipment is required because it is compatible with TABE testing software from CTB McGraw-Hill; this purchase of computer hardware is exempt from competitive procurement and that the purchase of Scantron scanners is a sole source entity and includes the Scantron educational discount; and,

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced purchasing opportunity and has determined that since it is sole-source related, this purchase is outside of the policies and procedures for M/WBE participation and does not require a waiver.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approves purchase orders in the total amount of \$38,817 to Scantron, Irvine, CA for the purchase of the scanners for colleges as listed above, and authorizes the Chairman to enter into an agreement with Scantron for a total amount not to exceed \$2,070.00 for the one-year maintenance of these systems at Daley, Malcolm X and Truman Colleges.
