REPORTS that students Camille Griffin and Cassandra Buchholz were part of a City Colleges delegation participating in the Salzburg Seminar May 28 to June 3 in Salzburg, Austria, a delegation led by Dr. Jose M. Aybar, Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Planning, and Research; and

that the Salzburg Seminar, founded in 1947, offers week-long study programs at its facility at Schloss Leopoldskron for students and faculty of U.S. higher education institutions to allow American students and teachers to explore issues of global concern from a variety of perspectives outside the United States; and

that the students also had a chance to explore Salzburg and nearby sites, including the former Nazi concentration camp outside Dachau.
