that proposals, contracts, and other special funding instruments are under development or have been submitted by staff at this time.

NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Employer Training Investment Program (PD# 051201)

Kennedy-King College has been awarded \$50,000 by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to provide training for small to mid-sized companies to upgrade skills of existing workers. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006.

Cooperative Work Study (PD# 051202)

Daley College has received funding from the Illinois Board of Higher Education for \$18,500, to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from April 5, 2005 until June 30, 2006.

Project MUSE (PD#051203)

Truman College has received an award from New Concepts Tutor/Mentor Connection, of Homewood, Illinois for up to \$19,116. The award will pay the cost of a Truman biology faculty member's extra assignment to develop and maintain a new on-line biology course (Dr. Kim Aaronson for \$4,500). It will also pay the cost of student supplies and materials (\$3,000) and the tuition and fees for up to 32 students at \$363 per student. The performance period for this award is from January 1, 2006 through August 30, 2006.

Paraprofessional Test Preparation Course Delivery Support (PD# 051204)

Daley College has received funding from the Illinois Community College Board for \$100,000 to train Chicago Public School paraprofessionals to pass the certification test requirements of the No Child Left Behind legislation. The performance period for this project is from August 25, 2005 through June 30, 2006.

ISBE - Child and Adult Care Food Program (PD#051205)

The District Office has requested \$189,300 for a program which subsidizes meal costs for children enrolled in Child Development Centers at the City Colleges of Chicago from the Illinois State Board of Education. The performance period for this project is from October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006.

AMENDMENTS

GEAR-UP EXTENSION (PD# 041113)

Northeastern Illinois University has awarded a final year continuation subcontract of \$285,400 to Truman College to support efforts to better align standards from high school to college and to improve readiness for college. The project will provide services which increase the proportion of students who leave high school prepared for college. The performance period for the final year of this project is from Sept. 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005. *This project has now been extended through June 30, 2006 with an additional \$150,000 of funding.*

that the Board of Trustees approve acceptance of any gifts, grants or other funding which may be forthcoming from these proposals and authorize the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Planning and Research, or the District Director for Grants and Contracts to serve as *authorized representative* or *official representative* of the District in the submission of proposals for funding and to execute all documents for the acceptance of this funding or these gifts; said acceptance to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantor, and said funds not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
