THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that it is necessary to amend Board Report #26882 dated August 4, 2005 for the purchase of books, periodicals, reference books, and instructional materials each year for students in the Adult Learning Skills Program and for the libraries at all Colleges and specialized career programs including: Health Occupation Career Programs, Computerized Numerical Control, Tool Technology and Offset Printing and Food Service Programs at Dawson Technical Institute, Kennedy-King College; and

that the Publishers list below is amended to include the purchase of Library books from **Congressional Quarterly, Inc.** and **West Group Inc.**; Trade books from **American Technical Publishers, Inc.**; Health Occupation books from **Elsevier Health Science**; and Culinary books from **Culinary & Hospitality Industry Publisher Services**; and

that bids were not solicited because the books and instructional materials are considered sole source and are exempt from competitive bidding; and

that exact quantities or costs of purchases cannot be determined because titles and quantities will vary depending upon each Colleges' requirements; and

that based on previous usage, estimated purchases from the following publishers/ distributors may exceed \$10,000 during FY2006:
