REPORTS

Dori Jacobsohn has worked with the Truman College Child Development Lab School since January 10, 2005 to develop and implement a fine arts curriculum. Her services were provided at a cost not to exceed \$8,000. Truman Lab Center has a need for Ms. Jacobsohn to continue providing her services through August 31, 2005 at an additional cost of \$3,500. The total cost of her services from January 10 through August 31, 2005 is not to exceed \$11,500.

Some of Ms. Jacobsohn's duties include:

- Working closely with CDS staff and Lab Center Director to develop a fine arts curriculum.
- Assisting the Director and staff to implement the curriculum.
- Providing on-going training to Truman child development center staff, and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced agreement continuation and has determined that since Dori Jacobson is continuing her role as fine arts curriculum specialist with continuity being of utmost importance, this activity is outside of the policies and procedures of the Board approved Participation Plan.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to enter into an agreement for the period of July 1, 2005 through August 31, 2005 to continue providing consultation and training to the Truman Child Development Laboratory Center at an additional cost of \$3,500.
