He serves as President of the Jewish Judges Association of Illinois, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Holocaust Memorial Foundation of Illinois, the John Marshall Law School Alumni Association, and the Lincolnwood Jewish Congregation.

that Judge Bender also serves on the Wright College Community Advisory Council and was featured as a City College Champion by WYCC.
