that the Food Service (FSS) Unit of Public Agency and Special Programs of Harold Washington College is honored to partner with the Greater Chicago Food Depository that feeds the hungry at over 600 Food Pantries through out the greater Chicago area. In partnering with "Pantry University", Harold Washington College will provide Food Service Sanitation classes to agency-sponsored volunteers at 70% of the prevailing tuition rate for the course in consideration for use of space in their facility for classes, and

that in addition, the FSS Unit of Public Agency and Special Programs will custom design training for pantry volunteers in food storage and handling, and

that classes at the Greater Chicago Food Depository location will be open to the public. The Greater Chicago Food Depository sponsored volunteers will be able to take the FSS class at any locations HWC offers the course.
