REPORTS

that in Board Report 26551 dated February 3, 2005 the Board approved the receipt of a U.S. Department of Labor subcontract grant to Daley College in the total amount of \$228,604.00 to develop and pilot a model to utilize integrated systems technology to train incumbent workers in advanced manufacturing careers; this program will be done in conjunction with Illinois State University; and

that the subcontract through Daley College included the purchase of industrial training equipment and integrated curriculum for skills in the areas of Electrical, Electronic and Mechanical training; staff prepared and issued a Request for Proposals for the necessary training equipment and curriculum, and the following proposal was received:

that staff has reviewed this proposal and finds it to be reasonable and acceptable; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced subcontract from the Department of Labor and determined that Aidex Corporation is in compliance based on recommended approval of their formal written request for a waiver from complying with Board approved Contract Compliance Plan MBE and WBE goals.
