DUAL ADMISSIONS PROGRAM AGREEMENT

Alliance Agreement

with

DEPAUL UNIVERSITY

The School of Computer Science, Telecommunications and Information Science

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that to be eligible for dual admission, students must apply for admission separately to each institution. Students must clearly indicate on each application that he or she is seeking admission into the Dual Admission Program. Each institution will review the applications independently according to its own established admissions criteria; and

that, as part of this Agreement, students will be permitted to move from the City Colleges of Chicago to enrollment at DePaul University after they have satisfied the Illinois Articulation Initiation Core Curriculum requirements at the City Colleges of Chicago. These students will have met DePaul University's general education core requirements but will have to meet the following mission-specific requirements at DePaul University: the experiential learning and senior year capstone courses, two philosophy and two religion courses that fulfill the liberal studies requirements; and

that both institutions agree to provide students participating in the Dual Admissions Program with a designated academic advisor; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced dual admissions program and recommends that this transaction receive a waiver from compliance with Board approved Participation Plan.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the Agreement with DePaul University stating the terms and conditions herein; and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Board.
