**REPORTS**

that in Board Report# 26431, dated November 6, 2004, the Board of Trustees renewed an agreement with PeopleSoft USA Inc. for annual maintenance services on the Contributor Relations, Campus Directory Interface and Portal software; and

that City Colleges was notified that PeopleSoft and Oracle merged and officially Oracle Corporation launched the combined company on Tuesday, January 18, 2005 and has been supporting the software since then; and

that Oracle Corporation has proposed to provide the necessary software updates and maintenance services on the above software modules for the period of November 6, 2005 through November 5, 2006, at a total cost of \$29,690.98; and

that OIT staff has determined that the proposal from Oracle is reasonable and acceptable, and recommends approval of the software support and maintenance service agreement for the period indicated above and this software maintenance services is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements; and

that the expenditure for these services is funded through the Office of Information Technology FY06 Operational budget; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced software maintenance opportunity and has determined that since this transaction is a continuation of previously established on-going services, this transaction is granted a waiver from compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan.

that the Board of Trustees approve the issuance of an agreement renewal per original agreement in the total amount of \$29,690.98 to Oracle to provide software upgrades and maintenance services pertaining to the Contributor Relations, Campus Directory Interface and Portal software from November 6, 2005 through November 5, 2006 and that the Chairman is authorized to execute any document pertaining to these professional services on behalf of the Board.
