REPORTS that during the months of September 15, 2005 – October 15, 2005, the Student Government Association is sponsoring a global exhibit on HIV/AIDS and Debt in Africa.

FURTHER that as a part of this City Colleges of Chicago major initiative, the Red Hot Embers exhibit is displayed in the Student Union, adjacent to the formal dining room, to ensure visibility, perusal and dissemination of information to the students, faculty and staff of Malcolm X College. As part of the Red Hot Embers Exhibit, a looping video is also shown on a wide screen television in the Student Union as a medium of providing testimonials and relevant information to the college as a whole.

FURTHER that at the first session of our Student Leadership Institute held on September 20, 2005, co-chaired by Professors Arnell Harris and Michael Callon, the Ruth Rosenstein Core Center provided a presentation on health issues relating to HIV/AIDS to the students attending the Student Leadership Institute.

The Red Hot Embers Exhibit provides a global view and perspective on HIV/AIDS impact and how this disabling disease also creates debt problems, especially for those countries and individuals who have been infected by the virus.
