GRANT

JCI Career Connect Program (PD# 050407)

Johnson Controls, Inc. has agreed to award equipment and installation services valued at \$86,000 to Kennedy-King College. The donation is to provide & install equipment to support the development of a Commercial Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning program. In return, Kennedy-King College will create & deliver the educational program, maintain the equipment, and recruit students over a five year period, beginning on April 6, 2006. The agreement calls for Kennedy-King College to purchase a five-year Planned Service Agreement (PSA), for maintenance of the equipment, at an annual cost of \$6,800 (\$34,000 for five years).

AMENDMENT

Critical Skills Shortage in Health Care (PD# 050506)

The District Office has received a subaward from a grant to Kerber, Eck and Braeckel, LLP from the Workforce Boards of Metropolitan Chicago. The subaward, of \$685,038, will be used to recruit and retain students in nursing programs at the City Colleges of Chicago. The performance period for this project is from February 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006. *MOWD has authorized the District to pay:*

- *up to \$200,000 to CAEL, in Chicago, for reimbursement of CSSI nursing student supplies and other services, and;*
- *up to \$50,000 to Working Class Uniforms, a division of Cintas, Inc. for the cost of CSSI nursing student uniforms.*

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS that the Board of Trustees approve acceptance of any gifts, grants or other funding which may be forthcoming from these proposals and authorize the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Planning and Research, or the District Director for Grants and Contracts to serve as *authorized representative* or *official representative* of the District in the submission of proposals for funding and to execute all documents for the acceptance of this funding or these gifts; said acceptance to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantor, and said funds not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
