REPORTS: that Wright College sophomore, Kwame Perry, has received the honors of being named to the first team Division IV All Region men's basketball team together with being the top vote getter in the region. He was also named to the first team, Region IV, All Tournament Team. For additional honors, Perry was also named to the first team of the North Central Community College Conference. He averaged 23.8 points and 9.8 rebounds per game during the 30 game season. The Region IV Athletic Committee has nominated Kwame Perry for All American honors with the National Junior College Athletic Association. Mr. Perry was named Most Valuable Player on Wright's men's team.

that on the distaff side, Martha Mauricio, also a sophomore at Wright College, has been honored by being named to the first team of the Division II's All Region women's basketball team. Martha was one vote short of being tied as the top vote getter in women's basketball. The voting has not yet been closed for top honors in the North Central Community College Conference where Martha was named to the second team last year. Her coaches feel confident that she will be voted to the first team this year. Martha averaged 24.4 points and 12.2 rebounds per game, had 123 steals and 185 assists in a 30 game season. Ms. Mauricio was also named Most Valuable Player on Wright's women's team.

that Bartosz Probola, a sophomore basketball player at Wright, also gets a "Presidential Award". He will graduate in May 2006 and has the opportunity to be named to the All Scholastic All American Team. At Wright College in the Fall of 2005, Bart received all A's while taking twenty hours of credit classes, for a 4.0 GPA. While taking eighteen credit hours in the Spring semester of 2006, Bart's grades are again all A's.
