NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Grow Your Own Teachers (PD# 061201)

Illinois State University is submitting a proposal to the Illinois State Board of Education for a project which would help communities train and retain teachers for local schools. The proposal, for \$200,000 includes a subcontract for Malcolm X College, of \$80,000, to pay for a coordinator, tuition, and tutors. The performance period for this project is from January 1, 2007 through June 30, 2007.

21st. Century Community Learning Centers (PD# 061202)

Northeastern Illinois University is awarding a subcontract of \$114,162 to Truman College to support after-school and Saturday programs serving Senn High School students. The prime award was issued by the Illinois State Board of Education and the performance period for the first year of this project is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

Workplace Skills Enhancement Project (PD# 061205)

The Business and Industry Services Department of Wright College has received funding of \$46,300 from the Illinois Secretary of State's Office to provide training in Workplace English as a Second Language for employees of the Columbia Metal Spinning Company (\$10,000), Freedman Seating Company (\$15,000), Horween Leather Company (\$10,300) and the Eli's Cheesecake Company (\$11,000). The performance period for the project is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

Malcolm X College TRIO - Upward Bound (PD# 061204)

Malcolm X College has submitted a proposal to the U.S. Department of Education for a new Upward Bound Project. The project provides instruction to at-risk high school students to enhance academic skills and increase motivation to succeed in post-secondary education. The project has requested

funding of \$250,000 for the first year of a five-year project. The performance period for the project is from September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2013.

Daley College TRIO - Upward Bound (PD# 061206)

Daley College has submitted a proposal to the U.S. Department of Education for a new Upward Bound Project. The project provides instruction to at-risk high school students to enhance academic skills and increase motivation to succeed in post-secondary education. The project has requested funding of \$317,212.41 for the first year of a five-year project. The performance period for the project is from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2013.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

ISBE - Child and Adult Care Food Program (PD#061203)

The District Office has received an award of \$209,277 for a program which subsidizes meal costs for children enrolled in Child Development Centers at the City Colleges of Chicago from the Illinois State Board of Education. The performance period for this project is from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.
