# CONTRACT ADDENDUM CERTIFICATE OF ADVANCED STUDY IN EARLY DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION (Board Report 26822, Dated July 14, 2005)

#### THE CHANCELLOR

that the Board of Trustees approved an agreement with The Erikson Institute in Board Report No. 26822 dated July 14, 2005 to develop and implement two courses and provide consultation to faculty at a cost not to exceed \$15,000 from July 14, 2005 through May 31, 2006; and

that it is necessary to amend the existing agreement with Erikson Institute in order to pay for tuition for three faculty members to participate in the second half of the mentoring course designed specifically for CCC faculty. Participants in the course must enroll at Erikson Institute in order to receive course credit. The coursework at Erikson will apply to a graduate degree and will benefit the District as they teach CCC Child Development students; and

that the cost for enrollment at Erikson Institute is \$595 a credit hour. The cost for three faculty to participate in the Spring two credit hour mentoring course will require an additional \$3,570; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced certificate for advanced study contract addendum opportunity and has determined that a request for a waiver from compliance be granted due to the already established coursework continuity which eliminates MBE or WBE subcontracting opportunities.

#### RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to amend the existing agreement with Erikson Institute to implement the second session of the CCC Child Development Faculty Mentoring Course at an additional cost not to exceed \$3,570.
