**NEW AWARD****Latino Technology Center (PD#060622)**

Wright College has received a subcontract award for \$67,100 from an award to the Battelle Memorial Institute from the US Department of Energy. The funding will allow Wright College's Humboldt Park Vocational Education Center (HPVEC) to develop a curriculum on wireless technology to be utilized for the Latino Development and Technology Commercialization Center. HPVEC will also recruit, screen and assess students and offer basic math and English components of the training. The performance period for this project is from April 10, 2006 through December 31, 2006.

**AMENDMENT****Cooperative Work Study (PD# 050902)**

Harold Washington College has received an award from the Illinois Board of Higher Education for \$26,000, to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from April 5, 2005 until June 30, 2006. This award includes payments to the following agencies to support the internship salaries of participating students

**Illinois Basic Operating Grant (PD#060524)**

WYCC Channel 20 anticipates the refunding of its grant from the Illinois Arts Council for a \$120,153 to be spent on basic operating costs of WYCC. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2006 through August 31, 2007. *The final paperwork shows that the \$120,153 was the first installment for this award. The second installment of \$207,315 makes the total award \$327,468.*
