that there is a need to purchase a 9,000 lb Scissor Rack for the Automotive Technology Department at Kennedy King College to replace an irreparable rack.; and

that specifications were prepared by District Procurement staff, publicly advertised, and specifications were mailed to seven firms. Bids were received from four firms: Snap-On Equipment, Pro-Tech, Rubber, Inc., and Chicago United Industries, Ltd., and the following responsive and responsible bids were received:

that staff has reviewed the bid submitted by the low bidder, Snap-On Equipment, and has determined that it's prices are reasonable and acceptable, and recommend the purchase of a 9,000 lb scissor rack be made from Snap-On Equipment; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced purchase for Kennedy-King college and has determined that since the 9000 lb scissor rack comes directly from manufacturer and that there are no MBE/WBE subcontracting opportunities and that Snap-On Equipment has requested a waiver from compliance, it is recommended that their request be granted.
