that in Board Report # 26590, dated March 3, 2005, the Board of Trustees approved an one year agreement with the Mercury Interactive Corporation for performance testing and monitoring services; and

that OIT is recommending that CCC continue to use the performance testing and monitoring services from Mercury Interactive which will provide critical information by conducting performance testing activities such as load testing, performance tuning, application diagnostics and capacity planning; and

that this service will assist OIT staff in analyzing the hardware configurations and application settings to help resolve potential performance issues; and

that OIT staff has received a continuation proposal from Mercury Interactive Corporation to provide the software and professional services for performance testing of the PeopleSoft systems and monitoring services for a period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$424,997.00 including expenses; and

that this professional service agreement and purchase of computer software is exempt from competitive procurement, and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced performance testing opportunity and since it is necessary for performance continuity to continue the current agreement, it is recommended that a waiver from compliance with both MBE and WBE goals of the Board approved Participation Plan be granted.

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the agreements with Mercury Interactive Corporation for software licenses and professional services to conduct performance testing activities and performance monitoring of the PeopleSoft systems for a period of one year at a total cost not to exceed \$424,997.00 including expenses and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute any documents pertaining to the software licenses and professional services on behalf of the Board.

that OIT has recommended to purchase performance testing and monitoring services from Mercury Interactive which will provide critical information by conducting performance testing activities such as load testing, performance tuning, application diagnostics and capacity planning; and

that this service will assist OIT staff to analyze the hardware configurations and application settings to help resolve potential performance issues; and

that OIT staff has received a proposal from Mercury Interactive Corporation to provide the software and professional services for performance testing of the PeopleSoft systems and monitoring services for a period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$424,997.00 including expenses; and

that this professional service agreement and computer software is exempt from competitive procurement and,

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced contract opportunity and has determined that since these professional services were acquired from a Chicago Public Schools (CPS) contract, CCC has been able to take advantage of the economic benefits of such a CPS reference, it has been deemed outside of the policies and procedures for M/WBE participation and does not require a waiver.
