SELECTS MALCOLM X COLLEGE FACULTY

REPORTS that the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) selected **Professor Helen Doss, Ph.D.** to participate in a professional development workshop. Dr. Doss will attend the NEH workshop entitled, *Concord, Massachusetts and American Utopian Thought in the Early Nineteenth Century*, July 2006. The workshop participants will engage in intensive study and discussion of important topics in US history. Scholars selected through a competitive process will have direct access to archival and primary source materials. The NEH workshops provide an opportunity for faculty to advance their scholarship and to develop enhanced teaching materials for the classroom; and

that the National Endowment for the Humanities is an independent grant-making agency of the US federal government. The summer workshop is offered as part of the *We the People* Initiative and provides stipends to the selected faculty. Dr. Helen Doss is a tenure track member of the Department of Communications and Fine Arts, teaching course in English and Literature.
