THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that in Board Report # 26960, dated October 5, 2005, the Board of Trustees authorized the District to extend the contract with Sentinel Technologies, Inc. for one year of the two year extension option, to provide on-site maintenance of computer equipment as specified in accordance with the Request for Proposal RFP # SC0203 which was issued in September, 2002; and

that the authorization allowed the District to achieve District-wide coordination and standardization of maintenance services on computer hardware, and take advantage of competitive pricing for the contract terms and option periods; and

that OIT recommends that the District exercise its last one year option with Sentinel Technologies, Inc. to maintain and repair computer hardware including microcomputers, laptops, printers, scanners, controllers, servers, SAN equipment, front end processors, high speed printers and related or specialized equipment; and

that is service will be competitively bid in Fiscal Year 08; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced on-site maintenance of the district-wide computer equipment and has determined that Sentinel Technologies, inc. continues to be in compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve the exercise of the last year option to renew the agreement from November 1, 2006 through October 31, 2007 with Sentinel Technologies, Inc. to provide on-site maintenance of computer equipment in the amount of \$490,000 and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute any documents pertaining to these services.
