#### **REPORTS**

that there is a need to purchase a Zetasizer Nanos Light Scattering Instrument to provide the Physical Sciences Department students and faculty with the resources to engage in undergraduate research related to the chemical sciences and;

that the proposal from Malvern Instruments to provide the equipment for \$38,060.00 has been reviewed and approved by college staff; this instrument uses dynamic light scattering to measure nanoparticle size and concentration in solution and is critical to the nanomaterial toxicity studies proposed; it can be used to characterize the size of proteins in solution and;

this purchase of equipment is exempt from competitive procurement since the equipment is available from a sole source entity; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced scientific equipment purchasing opportunity and has determined that since this instrument comes from only one source, it is recommended that a waiver from compliance from the Board approved Participation Plan be granted.
