REPORTS that City Colleges of Chicago Chancellor Dr. Wayne Watson was among the featured speakers at a forum on Darfur October 5 at Truman College; and

that the event, *Uprooted and Warehoused: Refugees from Darfur to Burma*, included a keynote address by State Senator Jacqueline Collins and presentations by 46th Ward Alderman Helen Shiller, activist and educator Prexy Nesbitt, Rwandan refugee and essayist Clemantine Wamariya, World Relief National Policy Director Jenny Hwang, and Burmese refugee activist Saw Daniel Htun-Lynn, all moderated by State Refugee Coordinator Edwin Silverman; and

that the forum, sponsored by more than a dozen community agencies, including Truman College, Alderman Shiller, and the Chicago Commission on Human Relations, was held in conjunction with an opening reception for the photo exhibit, *Surviving Darfur*, by Helen Caux.
