NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Re-Enrolled Student Project (PD# 061001)

Truman College has received an award of \$80,000 from The Alternative Schools Network, in Chicago for a project that will provide certified academic skills instructors to enhance the use of computer labs for academic programs at the Truman Middle College to better prepare students for post secondary education. The performance period for this award is from August 30, 2006 through July 31, 2007.

CONTINUATION GRANTS

Bridges to the Baccalaureate: Center for Science Success (PD# 061002)

The District Office has received funding for a continuation project from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for \$202,420 for the first year of the three year continuation. The project prepares and supports minority students from Washington, Olive-Harvey and Truman Colleges for transition to biomedical programs at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The performance period for the three year project is from September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2009. The first year project includes a subcontract to the University of Illinois at Chicago for \$66,630 (\$61,694 of direct costs and \$4,814 for facilities and administrative costs).
