NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Chicago High School Redesign Project (PD# 070401)

Wright College is submitting a proposal to the Polk Brothers Foundation to be a partner with the Chicago Academy High School in a three year project. The proposal requests \$50,000 per year and the performance period for the first year would be from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

Nursing School Expansion Grant Program (PD# 070402)

Truman College has received a grant of \$450,680 from the Illinois Board of Higher Education to be used to expand its nursing program and include an evening/weekend component. The performance period for this project is from February 6, 2007 through February 29, 2008.

Preventing Amputations in Hispanic Workers (PD# 070403)

Truman College is a partner in a University of Illinois Chicago proposal for \$1,967,836 to the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health to assess the impact of OSHA's NEP (National Emphasis Program). Truman's portion of the funding will be \$49,794 and the performance period for the project is from December 1, 2007 through November 30, 2012.

Minority Student Success in Transfer, Retention and Graduation (PD# 070404)

The District has received an award for \$290,000 as a subcontractor to Northeastern Illinois University's grant from the Illinois Board of Higher Education. The award will allow the District to enhance the transfer of City College of Chicago students to universities in Illinois. The performance period for this award is from April 1, 2007 through October 31, 2007.

Sara Lee Corporation Donation (PD# 070302)

Kennedy King College has been notified that The Washburne Culinary Institute will receive \$15,000 from the Sara Lee Corporation as a platinum level sponsorship of The Washburne Culinary Institute's 9th Annual Culinary and Hospitality Showcase on May 3, 2007.
