**REPORTS** that the Chicago Department on Aging and the City Colleges of Chicago, specifically, Kennedy-King College have entered into a joint agreement to offer classes to Chicago's senior citizens, 55 years of age and older at two Chicago Department on Aging regional senior centers.

that pursuant to this agreement the **Chicago Department on Aging** agrees to provide Kennedy-King College's Continuing Education with a suggested list of classes for them to offer no less than four weeks prior to the publication of their quarterly Life Enrichment brochure and the listing of classes on the Department on Aging's website.

that the Department of Aging agrees to query its student participants to determine their level of satisfaction with the subject matter, the subject matter's presentation and instructor. Furthermore, the Department of Aging will solicit suggestions for new class offerings. The results of the evaluation and inquiry process will be shared with Kennedy-King College in a timely manner.

that pursuant to this agreement **Kennedy-King College** agrees to send College staff to register students on the first day of class in accordance with the requirements of the City College registration procedures.

that to retain qualified instructors who will teach classes in a professional manner. Said instructor should have had prior experience working with the older adult population.
