**REPORTS** that on March 7, 2007, the Chicago Southside Sarcoidosis Support Group held its first educational symposium at Olive-Harvey College. The college's Respiratory Care Program and its first and second year students were hosted the symposium; and

that first-year students of the college's Nursing Program attended the symposium and approximately 100 people from the college and community were in attendance to learn more about Sarcoidosis, a lung disease that extends to almost every body organ; and

that presenters at the symposium were renowned physicians from hospitals and health agencies including Northwestern Memorial Hospital, St. Joseph/Rush North Hospital, Northwestern Medicine and Palliative Care, and the Foundation for Sarcoidosis Research of Chicago; and

that presentations covered how to treat/care for the mind and body of a person affected by the disease; fostering collaborative relationships among patients, families and their caregivers; seeking funding for research and the importance of support groups for chronically ill patients, families and caregivers.
