that Olive Branch Mission provides a comprehensive array of year-round services for homeless men, women and children; 7 to 9 month long-term residential recovery for men struggling with addiction to heroin, cocaine, alcohol, marijuana and tobacco; job readiness and employment training for individuals transitioning from homelessness to full-time employment and self-sufficiency; after-school tutorial support for homeless children who must keep up academically in their respective schools, fully accredited academic and internship training for graduate and undergraduate university students; life-skills seminars and case-management support for homeless individuals and families transitioning to stable homes and long-term employment; to walk-in clients comprehensive community-based support and referrals/access through its Community Resource Center

that the African American Heritage Committee food drive was an overwhelming success collecting over 800 pounds (.37 tons) of food and toiletries.
