NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Illinois Support, Training & Employment Program (ISTEP) (PD# 070801)

Malcolm X College has received an award of \$58,410 from the Illinois Department of Labor for a project that will assist participating displaced homemakers in achieving economic self-sufficiency through education, training and employment. The project will provide advising, training, career assessment, life skills and job related workshops and referrals to a variety of organizations and agencies. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

Dropout Retrieval: Empowerment for Academic Matriculation (PD# 070802)

The District Office anticipates receiving preliminary notification of refunding by the Youth Connection Charter School (with funds flowing through the Chicago Public Schools) for a program to provide academic programs and services for retrieved high school dropouts in the CCC middle colleges. Anticipated funding for the Middle College Program at Olive-Harvey College is \$899,582 and at Truman College is \$820,548. Additional funds will be provided by the Illinois State Board of Education under *Supplemental General State Aid* (SGSA) and by the U.S. Department of Education using Title I funding. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

CPS Dawson Partnership (PD# 070803)

Dawson Technical Institute has received an award of \$400,000 from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. The project will focus on providing services to expand the number of minority individuals, women, and individuals from “hard-to-serve” populations who

enter and complete building trades apprenticeship programs and achieve journey level status within a building trades union in Cook County. The performance period for this project is from June 1, 2007 through May 31, 2009.

Student Success Grant (PD# 070804)

The District Office anticipates an award of \$710,121 from the Illinois Community College Board. Student Success Grant funding is intended to provide needed supplemental services to assist students in developing the academic skills necessary to remedy or correct educational deficiencies to allow the attainment of college educational goals. Allowable expenditures for this project include: personnel, supplemental instructional materials, auxiliary aids and services, instructional equipment, staff development, contractual services, and other expenditures (if approved in writing by the appropriate ICCB staff). The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

Summer Programs Food Services (PD# 070806)

The City Colleges of Chicago has been approved for funding of \$43,605 from the Illinois State Board of Education to provide food services (lunch and snacks) for participants of Summer, 2007 programs at three of the colleges. The programs involved will be the Upward Bound Program at Daley College and Malcolm X College, Educational Talent Search at Malcolm X College and a Summer Learning Camp at Olive Harvey College. The District's approved vendor for cafeteria and vending services, the Compass Group, will be utilized for these programs. Food services would be provided during the period from June 25, 2007 through August 30, 2007.

Bridge Pathways in Adult Education (PD# 070807)

The City Colleges of Chicago has received an award from the Illinois Community College Board for \$160,000 for a project which will support transitions between adult education, career education, and credit programs. The project will focus on healthcare programs and will primarily involve Harold Washington College, Malcolm X College and Wilbur Wright College. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

CONTINUATION PROJECTS

Chicago Housing Authority (PD# 070805)

The Chicago Housing Authority has exercised its option to extend its Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the District and to provide an

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additional \$1,070,000 of funding (for a new total of \$1,570,000) for a project which provides educational services for CHA residents and relocatees. The original contract period was from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2006. The 1st year option period is from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 and one option year remains for an additional extension.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees approve acceptance of any gifts, grants or other funding which may be forthcoming from these proposals and authorize the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Planning and Research, or the District Director for Grants and Contracts to serve as *authorized representative* or *official representative* of the District in the submission of proposals for funding and to execute all documents for the acceptance of this funding or these gifts and the operation of the funded projects; said acceptance to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantor, and said funds not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
