**NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS**

**MSTQE (PD#070601)**

Northeastern Illinois University has awarded Wright College with a subcontract for \$10,000 to be utilized for faculty and administrative support for NEIU's MSTQE program. The performance period for this program is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

**Cooperative Work Study (PD# 070602)**

Kennedy-King College has received funding from the Illinois Board of Higher Education for \$10,400, to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from April 1, 2007 until June 30, 2008.

**American Biotechnology Experience (PD# 070603)**

Truman College has received a grant for \$6,000 from Meitetsu Company of California to be used for training expenses related to the Japanese science exchange program. The performance period for this project is from November 22, 2006 through November 30, 2007.

**CPB Digital Nielsen Encoder Program (PD# 070627)**

WYCC has received notice that it will receive reimbursement of \$4,110.00 from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for the purchase of a digital Nielsen encoder. The item was purchased for \$6,850.00 on February 1, 2007.

**Tools for Automotive Tech Students (PD# 070628)**

The District Office has submitted a request for \$13,750 to *My Hometown Helper - Hamburger Helper* to purchase tool sets for 25 students who are transitioning from the Automotive Bridge course to the certificate program.

The performance period for this award is from June 1, 2007 through May 30, 2008.

**Food Sanitation Certificate (PD# 070629)**

Harold Washington College has received an award from the Chicago Park District of \$15,000 to provide training for Chicago Park District staff. The performance period for this award is from May 23, 2007 through May 30, 2007.

**Authentic Research and Career Based Learning Projects in Molecular Biology (PD# 070630)**

Harold Washington College has submitted a request to the National Science Foundation for a grant of \$200,000 to fund a project that will provide 48 undergraduate students with guided-inquiry activities in molecular biology. The performance period for this project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**CSSI Manufacturing and TWL (PD# 070631)**

Daley College has submitted a request for \$112,500 to the Workforce Boards of Metropolitan Chicago for the second year of a project to train WIA eligible, dislocated/low income workers to meet critical skills shortages in Illinois' Northeast Economic Development Regions' transportation, warehousing and logistics industry. The performance period for this project is from May 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008.

**CONTINUATION AWARDS**

**Our Money Matters: The ABC's of Personal Finance (PD#041023 - YR3)**

The District has been refunded for \$208,000 by the Treasurer's Office of the City of Chicago for the second year of a project in which 12 Chicago area financial institutions will participate along with all seven of the City Colleges of Chicago. The project will offer seminars to assist citizens of Chicago with personal finances and banking. The performance period for the second year of the project is from July 1, 2006 until June 30, 2007.

**ANNUAL AWARD REFUNDING**

**Adult Education -State Basic (PD# 070604)**

The District Office has requested funding of \$3,700,000 from The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) to provide instructional services for Adult

Basic Education and English as a Second Language at all seven colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. As part of this grant, City Colleges of Chicago will subcontract with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Urban Schools in the amount of \$25,000 and with Logan Square Neighborhood Association in the amount of \$80,000.

**Adult Education -State Performance (PD# 070605)**

The District Office has requested funding of \$2,500,000 from The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) to provide instructional services for Adult Basic Education and English as a Second Language at all seven colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. As part of this grant, City Colleges of Chicago will subcontract with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Urban Schools in the amount of \$25,000 and with Logan Square Neighborhood Association in the amount of \$80,000.

**Adult Education - State Public Assistance (PD# 070606)**

The District Office has requested funding of \$4,000,000 from The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) to provide instructional services for public assistance clients at all seven colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Adult Education -Federal Basic (PD# 070607)**

The District Office has requested funding of \$3,800,000 from The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) to provide instructional services for Adult Basic Education and English as a Second Language at all seven colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Adult Education -Federal EL/Civics (PD# 070608)**

The District Office has requested funding of \$1,000,000 from The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) to provide instructional services for English as a Second Language at all seven colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Federal Tech Prep(PD# 070609)**

The District Office anticipates an allocation of Tech Prep - Federal grant funds of \$495,550 to support vocational/technical career programs at the City Colleges of Chicago. Funding will be provided by the Illinois Community College Board, utilizing Federal *flow-through* dollars. This year, emphasis will be placed on increasing the number of articulated agreements for occupational programs with both secondary schools and senior post secondary institutions. The period of performance for the project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Carl D. Perkins, Title III (PD# 070610)**

The City Colleges of Chicago anticipates a preliminary grant allocation under the federal Carl D. Perkins Title III program of \$3,536,416 from the Illinois Community College Board, utilizing funds from the U.S. Department of Education. The federal grant is designed to improve student performance in career and technical education programs as measured by a set of core indicators specified in the local plan guidelines. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Program Improvement Grant (PD#070611)**

The City Colleges of Chicago anticipates receiving an award of \$128,232 from the Illinois Community College Board for purchase of equipment for career programs on each campus. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Early School Leavers Program (PD# 070612)**

The District Office anticipates receiving preliminary notification of the award of \$287,686 to continue the Early School Leavers program, a project funded by the Illinois Community College Board with the purpose of providing an array of opportunities for youths, age 16 to 21 years, to re-engage in school and earn a high school diploma or GED credential while receiving intensive career preparation services. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Student Support Services - Daley College (PD# 070614)**

Daley College has requested funding from the US Department of Education for \$235,689 for the third year of a five year project to support the academic success of entering students who are "at-risk". The performance period for the first year of the project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**Student Support Services - Olive-Harvey College (PD# 0070615)**

Olive-Harvey College has requested funding from the US Department of Education for \$203,979 for the third year of a five year project to support the academic success of entering students who are "at-risk". The performance period for the first year of the project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**Student Support Services - Wright College (PD# 070616)**

Wright College has requested funding from the US Department of Education for \$220,000 for the third year of a five year project to support the academic success of entering students who are "at-risk". The performance period for the first year of the project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**Student Support Services - Truman College (PD# 070617)**

Truman College has requested funding from the US Department of Education for \$219,672 for the third year of a five year project to support the academic success of entering students who are "at-risk". The performance period for the first year of the project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**Student Support Services - Malcolm X College (PD# 070618)**

Malcolm X College has requested funding from the US Department of Education for \$219,911 for the third year of a five year project to support the academic success of entering students who are "at-risk". The performance period for the first year of the project is from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

**Early School Leavers Program (PD# 070619)**

The District Office anticipates preliminary notification that it will receive \$287,686 to continue the Early School Leavers program, a project funded by the Illinois Community College Board with the purpose of providing an array of opportunities for youths, age 16 to 21 years, to re-engage in school and earn a high school diploma or GED credential while receiving intensive career preparation services. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Truants' Alternative and Optional Education Program (TAOEP) (PD# 070620)**

The District Office anticipates funding of \$2,000,000 for a continuation project from the Illinois State Board of Education. This program is a unique partnership between public, private and community-based organizations designed to provide alternative educational programs and services to reclaimed youth, 16-21 years old, who have dropped out of high school. The Truman Middle College will receive \$414,010 and the Olive Harvey Middle College will receive \$414,010 from this funding. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. From the grant funds, the following diploma programs and GED programs will utilize subcontracts from the City Colleges of Chicago:

**Community Services Agreement (PD# 070621)**

The District Office anticipates an award from the Illinois Department of Human Services of \$738,349 to the to support Site Administered Child Care Programs (\$220,000) and Developmental Disabilities Programs at Harold Washington College (\$518,394). The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Community College Tech Prep Support Grant (PD# 070622)**

The District anticipates and award from the Illinois Community College Board of \$64,135 to be used for identification, reporting, and assessment of post secondary Tech Prep students and testing and placement of secondary Tech Prep students. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Career and Technical Education Grant Agreement (PD# 070623)**

The District Office anticipates an award of \$140,000 from the Illinois Community College Board (utilizing Federal Perkins funding) for Continuous Quality Improvement activities (\$70,000) and Performance Enhancement activities (\$70,000) related to post secondary career and technical education programs. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**Workforce Development Grant (PD# 070625)**

The District Office anticipates an award of \$257,160 from the Illinois Community College Board to support business and industry service programs at all of the colleges. The period of performance for this program is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**State Prekindergarten Sub-contracting Project (PD#070626)**

The District Office has submitted a request for \$504,187 to the Chicago Public Schools to continue to provide preschool experience for three and four year old children who are at risk of academic failure at Daley, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Oliver-Harvey and Truman Colleges. The performance period for the project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

**THE CHANCELLOR**
