THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that in Board Report # 26593, dated March 3, 2005, the Board of Trustees authorized an agreement with SDI for professional consulting services for the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007; and

that OIT is in the process of reorganizing the department to strengthen its direct management of day to day support and project management of PeopleSoft upgrades and implementations; and

that during this transition planning period, OIT has identified two SDI consultants who have the necessary management skills and experience to become City College employees to manage the library system and to provide overall management of the going PeopleSoft projects; and

that SDI has proposed a transition release fee of \$47,200.00 for the two consultants and that OIT has determined that this best serves the district as it will provide stabilization of the library system and improve the management of the PeopleSoft projects; and

the Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced professional consulting service transaction and since this involves the transition of two consultants to City College employee status and since this is not open to subcontracting of certified MBE or WBE vendors, it is recommended that a waiver from compliance from the Board approved Participation Plan be granted.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chairman to execute an amended agreement in the amount of \$47,200.00 including expenses with SDI, Chicago, IL for a one-time transition release fee for the two consultants.
