#### **REPORTS**

that in Board Report# 27182 adopted February 9, 2006 approval was given to purchase Micro Optic Exclusive Microscopes through the sole provider Micro-Optics, NY for the use of the Natural Science Department at Daley College; and

that in order to receive the merchandise by June 30, 2007 pre-approval from the Board Chairman was requested and approved for the issuance of a purchase order to Micro-Optics; and

that Micro-Optics has an exclusive agreement with Motic Instruments, the manufacturer of the BA300 Microscopes, to reconfigure its BA300 model to better meet student needs and enhance the educational features of the Microscope by retooling the eye piece so that a wider field of vision is possible, and that the configuration is available exclusively through Micro-Optics for a period of 5 years; and

that staff request approval to purchase an additional 36 Micro Optic Exclusive Microscopes from Micro-Optics at a total cost of \$ 48,240.15 to support the Natural Science Department; and

that the purchase of the 36-Micro Optic Exclusive Microscopes from the sole source developer is exempt from the District's competitive bidding requirements; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced microscope purchase opportunity, and since this is a sole source transaction, and there are no MBE or WBE sub contract opportunities, it is recommended that Micro-Optics be granted a waiver from compliance with the Board approved Paricipation Plan.

#### RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees ratifies the Chairman's pre-approval to issue a purchase order to Micro-Optics, NY in the total amount of \$48,240.15 for the purchase of the BA300MCP Exclusive Microscopes for the Natural Science Department at Daley College.
