that in February 2007, Malcolm X College Nephrology/Renal Program entered into a partnership with the National Kidney Foundation of Illinois. Under the leadership of Patricia Williams, Program Director and the coordination of Dr. Ahmed Khan, Instructor, community screening has been incorporated into the curriculum. This screening detects potentially susceptible individuals for factors causing kidney diseases and also detects kidney diseases at an early stage; and

with this partnership the students will have structured training to assess and evaluate individuals coming for a check up and learn to perform basic screening laboratory tests. The students under the supervision of college instructors will participate in this community screening once a month. Through this initiative and the programs partnership, students will practice the core value of Malcolm X College by supporting our community and by promoting and cooperating in activities that enhance the quality of life.
