REPORTS

that Wright College hosted a Worldwide Youth in Science and Engineering (WYSE) Academic Challenge Regional Competition on Friday, February 16, 2007. One hundred and twenty-eight (128) students from nine Chicago high schools (Lane Technical, Josephinum Academy, Luther High School North, Providence-St. Mel, Resurrection, St. Ignatius College Prep, St. Francis de Sales, Quigley Preparatory Seminary, and Von Steuben Metro) competed. In Division Unltd., the first place trophy was awarded to Lane Tech High School. In Division 1500, first and second and third place trophies were awarded to St. Ignatius, Von Steuben, and Resurrection high schools. The first-place trophy went to St. Francis de Sales in Division 700. In the smallest division 300, first, second, and third place trophies were awarded to Archbishop Quigley Preparatory Seminary, Providence-St. Mel, and Luther North high schools, respectively. First, second, and third place medallions were awarded to individual competitors in each of seven academic categories. Teams and individuals placing in first and second place in each division will advance to a Sectional competition at North Central College in Naperville on March 16th. The office of the Dean of Instruction coordinated this event.
