that proposals, contracts, and other special funding instruments are under development or have been submitted by staff at this time.

NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

MSTOE (PD#070501)

Northeastern Illinois University has awarded Truman College with a subcontract for \$20,000 to be utilized for curriculum and program development which will allow Truman to prepare teachers, via the new ATE (Associate of Teacher Education) degree to teach at the middle school level. After earning an ATE degree from Truman, these students can go to NEIU, or another teacher education university, to complete a full teacher education baccalaureate degree. The performance period for this program is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

The Illinois Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (PD# 070502)

Six of the colleges have received subcontracts of a grant from the National Science Foundation which was funded to Chicago State University. The subcontracts provide \$1,000, each, to Truman, Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Wright, Olive-Harvey and Daley. The goals of the project are to enhance the participation of minority students in science, mathematics and engineering. The period of performance for the subcontracts is from November 1, 2006 until October 31, 2007.

Illinois Star Pilot Site (PD# 070503)

Truman College has received an award from Illinois State University, utilizing Illinois Community College Board funds, for \$1750 to support Truman's participation as a pilot site in the STAR Reading Project. Truman will send representatives to training sessions and complete pre-tests and post-tests for this adult education program. The performance period for this project will be from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

Organization of Transportation Investment/Operations (PD#070504)

Daley College has received an extension to its subcontract with an additional \$25,000 (for a current total of \$200,000) from the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System as part of a grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation. Daley College will assist in leadership training and data collection related to regional transportation issues. The performance period for this project from April 1, 2000 has now been extended until September 30, 2007.

Illinois Basic Operating Grant (PD#070505)

WYCC Channel 20 has received notice of the refunding of its grant from the Illinois Arts Council for \$229,021 to be spent on basic operating costs of WYCC. The performance period for this project is from July 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.

DCFS Tuition Assistance Intergovernmental Agreement (PD# 070405)

The Illinois Department of Children and Family Services has made an award of up to \$100,000 to the City Colleges of Chicago to provide tuition assistance (including books and fees) for youth under DCFS guardianship who take classes at the City Colleges of Chicago. The performance period for this award is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

DePaul Bridge Program (PD#070406)

DePaul University has subcontracted with Truman College for \$38,555, using funds from the Illinois Board of Higher Education, for a project to expand the bridge program to serve immigrant students at both Truman and Wright Colleges, by supporting their efforts to obtain baccalaureate degrees. The performance period for this project is from October 10, 2006 through October 31, 2007.

Teacher Quality Enhancement Grant Partnership (PD# 070407)

Illinois State University has provided a subaward of \$43,400 to Truman College from a US Department of Education award. In this project, Truman will coordinate activities with the Chicago Public Schools and expand the "More Teachers for Chicago" program by recruiting students for the Truman, Associate of Arts in Teaching program and articulating this program with Illinois State University. The performance period for this subaward is from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

Sponsorship for Kennedy-King College Grand Opening Marketing and Promotional Activities (PD# 070506)

Kennedy-King College and the District Office of Marketing will submit

proposals to McDonald's, Walgreens, National City, Wal-mart, Lawry's, WBEZ and Power 92 for sponsorship participation in a series of grand opening promotional activities for the new Kennedy-King College. Proposal requests will range between \$5,000 and \$30,000 for varying levels of participation. These promotional activities will take place between June 30 and August 30, 2007. Campus previews will be conducted during June and July. A series of grand opening events is being planned for the week of August 20 - 26, 2007.

AMENDMENTS

Integrated Systems Technology (PD#050203)

Daley College will receive a subcontract, of \$228,604, from an award to Illinois State University made by the US Department of Labor. The project will develop and pilot a model to utilize integrated systems technology to train incumbent workers in the Chicago area in advanced manufacturing careers. The performance period for the project is from October 1, 2004 through June 30 2006. *Daley has now received a "no-cost" extension which changes the end date of the project to October 31, 2007.*
