PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT

THE CHANCELLOR

REPORTS

that in Board Report Number #27939 Adopted April 12, 2007 the Board of Trustees authorized the Chairman to enter into an agreement with Gregory Light, Ph.D. in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 to provide the train the trainer model for City Colleges of Chicago from April 12, 2007 through July 30, 2007; and

that there is a need to increase the contract amount for services for Gregory Light , Ph.D. to provide training for thirty-three (33) administrators; and

that the proposed consultant Gregory Light, Ph.D. will train thirty-three (33) administrators from May 21-23 in the following areas:

- Evaluation of assessment practices
- Student learning outcome development
- Active learning practice

that the estimated additional cost of \$3,000 for the train the trainer model to be provided from April 12, 2007 through July 30, 2007 brings the total contract amount to \$18,000; and

that all other requirements remain the same; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above revised professional services agreement and has determined that since the aforementioned nationally-recognized consultants were previously granted a waiver from compliance , it is recommended that their waiver from compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan be continued.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECOMMENDS

that the Board of Trustees authorize the increase of \$3,000 and authorize the Chairman to enter into an agreement with Gregory Light, Ph.D to provide the trainer the trainer model for City Colleges of Chicago from April 12, 2007 through July 30, 2007, with a total cost not to exceed \$18,000.00.
