**REPORTS**

that the Harold Washington College Male Mentoring Program Committee sponsored an Expungement, Sealing and Clemency Workshop on Thursday, March 22, 2007. This was the second of three events scheduled for the Spring 2007 semester to be sponsored by the Male Mentoring Program Committee, funded by the College, and;

that with assistance from faculty member, Ellen Eason-Montgomery, the HWC Criminal Justice Club, in conjunction with the HWC Applied Science Department and the HWC Student Resource Center, the Male Mentoring Program Committee was able to schedule Attorney Vicki Rogers, Chief of Legal Resources Division of the Public Defender's Office as our Workshop Presenter. Attorney Kim Sorrels, Supervisor in the Legal Resources Division and Attorney Darlene Williams, Chief of the First Municipal Division of the Public Defender's Office assisted with the workshop. This workshop was open to all Washington students and staff, and to the general public, and;

that the workshop provided an opportunity for Washington students and staff, and members of the public, to learn a great deal about the Expungement, Sealing and Clemency legal processes. Participants were also afforded the opportunity to meet one-on-one with the attorneys to obtain assistance with their personal Expungement, Sealing or Clemency matters, and;

that the workshop was very well attended with 97 participants, consisting of 73 students of the City Colleges of Chicago, 2 staff members, 2 faculty members, and 20 members of the general public. They learned about the workshop on the Harold Washington College website. 27 participants were seen one-on-one by the attorneys, and;

that Vicki Rogers, the presenter, and Kim Sorrels and Darlene Williams were excellent and very responsive to the legal needs of staff, students and members of the general public.
