NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS

Hospitality Bridge Curriculum (PD# 070201)

Harold Washington College has received an award of \$35,000 from the Chicago Workforce Board to develop curricula and relations with prospective employers for a program in hospitality, restaurant and retail industries. The performance period for this project is from December 1, 2006 through March 15, 2007 with the possibility of a no cost extension, if requested.

Blended On-Line Learning Grant (PD# 070202)

Truman College has received an award of \$210,314 from the Illinois Community College Board to review and develop healthcare curricula for a healthcare blended on-line bridge program, to format the curriculum into an on-line format and to purchase laptop computers. The performance period for the project is from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

Initiative for Minority Students - Bridges to the Baccalaureate (PD# 070203)

The District Office has received funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for \$215,742 for the first year of a five year project. The project will prepare and support 65 minority students from Kennedy-King, Daley, Wright and Malcolm X Colleges for transition to biomedical programs at the University of Illinois at Chicago. This project includes a subcontract of \$68,580 to the University of Illinois at Chicago. The performance period for year three of project is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2012.

Cooperative Work Study (PD# 070204)

Harold Washington College has submitted a proposal to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for \$80,000, to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is

from April 1, 2007 until June 30, 2008.

Cooperative Work Study (PD# 070205)

Wright College has submitted a proposal for \$40,000 to the Illinois Board of Higher Education to support cooperative work study programs by paying a portion of the salaries that students earn while in their internship positions in business and industry. The performance period for this project is from April 1, 2007 until June 30, 2008.

Nursing Program Expansion (PD# 070206)

Truman College has submitted a proposal for \$495,973 to the Illinois Board of Higher Education to fund a program which will expand Truman's nursing program with an evening and weekend option. The performance period for this project is from February 1, 2007 through January 30, 2008.
