that Malcolm X College is recognized as one of the 2006 High Performers by the CCSSE (Community College Survey of Student Engagement), a nationally-known survey research group housed at the University of Texas at Austin; and

that based on the survey results; the CCSSE selects eight Higher Performers for each of the five benchmarks annually. Out of 444 institutions who participated in the 2006 Community College Survey of Student Engagement, Malcolm X College is listed among High Performers for four benchmarks, which are Active and Collaborating Learning, Academic Challenge, Student Effort, and Student-Faculty Interaction.

that the recognition is published in the *Highlights* of the Community College Survey of Student Engagement and available at <http://www.ccsse.org/publications/November2006.pdf>; and

that 719 Malcolm X College credit students from 53 class sections participated in the 2006 Community College Survey of Student Engagement. These students were randomly selected by the CCSSE research group and represented 20 percent of the students who were enrolled in the credit programs in spring 2006. The results are obtained from a methodologically-sound sampling and the findings are generalizable.
