**NEW PROPOSALS OR GRANTS**

**DePaul Bridge Program Expansion (PD# 070101)**

Truman College will receive \$64,000 and Wright College will receive \$55,600 from an award issued to DePaul University from the Illinois Board of Higher Education. The project will expand the bridge program which supports City Colleges of Chicago students who go on to DePaul University to earn bachelor's degrees. The performance period for this project is from.

**Homeland Security Industry Education (PD# 070102)**

Wright College has received an award for \$90,000 from the Illinois Community College Board for a project which will develop and implement training programs for information technology professionals on the topic of "secure application development". The performance period for this project is from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

**Heal Illinois (PD# 070105)**

The District Office has submitted a proposal for \$298,010 for the first year of a three year grant to the Health Resources and Services Administration of the US Department of Health and Human Services. The project would increase the presence of underrepresented populations in the nursing profession across the State of Illinois. The performance period for the award is from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010.

**Center for Authentic Science Practice in Education - CASPiE (PD# 070106)**

Olive-Harvey College has received an award of \$4,000 from Purdue University as a subcontract from a National Science Foundation award. The purpose of the funding is to develop and implement a research module for undergraduate physics courses. The performance period for this funding is from August 1, 2006 through July 30, 2007.

## CONTINUATION GRANTS

### Food Service Sanitation Training (PD# 070103)

Harold Washington College has been awarded an additional \$86,657, from the Chicago Department of Public Health, to provide a Food Handling & Sanitation Certification Program. The new agreement will extend the contract with the agency for an additional term, from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.

### Center for Authentic Science Practice in Education - CASPiE (PD# 070107)

Harold Washington College has received an additional award of \$4,000 (for a cumulative total of \$12,000) from Purdue University as a subcontract from a National Science Foundation award. The purpose of the funding is to develop and implement a research module for undergraduate chemistry courses. The performance period for this additional funding is from August 1, 2006 through July 30, 2007.

## AMENDMENTS

### GEAR-UP EXTENSION (PD# 070104)

Northeastern Illinois University has awarded a continuation subcontract of an additional \$177,602 to Truman College to support efforts to better align standards from high school to college and to improve readiness for college. The project will provide services which increase the proportion of students who leave high school prepared for college. The performance period for this extension of the project is from Sept. 1, 2006 through August 31, 2007.
