that the Head Start / Child Care Collaboration proposal is under development and will be submitted by staff in the near future.

Head Start / Child Care Collaboration (PD# 080810)

City Colleges of Chicago has completed an application to be submitted to the Chicago Children and Youth Services Department (CYS) for continued funding of the Head Start Program for children of low income parents at the Kennedy-King, Malcolm X, Olive-Harvey, and Truman Child Development Centers. The District is applying for 95 Head Start Collaboration slots, which would provide funding in the amount of \$457,710 for 95 children for ½ of the day. The performance period for the grant is from December 1, 2008 to November 30, 2009.

that the Board of Trustees approve acceptance of any gifts, grants or other funding which may be forthcoming from this proposal and authorize the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, or the District Director for Grants and Contracts to serve as *authorized representative* or *official representative* of the District in the submission of proposals for funding and to execute all documents for the acceptance of this funding or these gifts and the operation of the funded projects; said acceptance to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth by the grantor, and said funds not to be expended by the Board for any other purposes.
