REPORTS that on April 3, 2008 Board Report #28623 amended Board Report #28111 adopted on June 20, 2007 to include the Center for Applied Linguistic to the approved list of testing materials for the adult education program; and

that based on the state requirements for testing and materials and the introduction of a new standardized curriculum in adult education, the staff recommends approval to increase the spending authorization for the Association of Classroom Teachers Testers and for Curriculum Publications Clearinghouse as follows; and:
