THE CHANCELLOR

that in Board Report 28098, dated June 20, 2007, for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, the Board approved a license agreement with Compuware Corporation which allows OIT to perform critical performance testing activities such as load testing, performance tuning, application diagnostics and capacity planning of the PeopleSoft Student Administration, Financial and Human Resources systems; and

that load testing is a critical component completed during any version upgrade or patches made to the district's PeopleSoft applications; and

that OIT requested a three year agreement in order to reduce the annual cost and avoid price increases during FY10 and FY11; and

that OIT staff has received a proposal from Compuware to provide the software maintenance at a total cost not to exceed \$155,793.00 for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2011; and

that OIT staff has reviewed the proposal from ICN and found it to be reasonable and acceptable; and

that this software maintenance service agreement and purchase of computer software is exempt from competitive procurement; and

that the Office of M/WBE Contract Compliance has reviewed the above referenced agreement amendment and since Compuware Corporation is using certified MBE and WBE vendors in the conduct of their business on an indirect basis, therefore, it has been determined that they are in compliance with the Board approved Participation Plan.

RECOMMENDS

THE CHANCELLOR

that the Board of Trustees approve the agreements with Compuware Corporation for software maintenance support for a period of three years from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2011 at a total cost not to exceed \$155,793.00 and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute any documents pertaining to the software licenses, software maintenance and professional services on behalf of the Board.
